Must testify in suit.

Minnelli's unwanted court gig

A Manhattan judge is ordering Liza Minnelli to sing.

In a decision made public yesterday, Supreme Court Justice Paul Feinman ordered Liza to answer questions under oath in her former driver's \$100 million sexual-harassment suit against her.

Minnelli, 63, for years has managed to put off being deposed in M'Hammed Soumayah's suit — and Feinman, who recently took over the case, said enough was enough.

He ordered her to attend a deposition on Nov. 17 and 18.

Soumayah's 2004 court action charges the Oscar winner was an abusive drunk who forced him to "engage in sexual relations" with her.

Minnelli filed a \$250,000 countersuit against Soumayah, charging that he began threatening her when she told him she would have to reduce his \$238,000-a-year salary.
